At Albert College there are many exciting co-curricular activities to choose from which we call Albert's A's – Academics, Arts, Athletics, Active Citizenship and Adventure.

### Academics

Small class sizes allow for close relationships to form between students and teachers. The curriculum meets or exceeds that standards set by the Ontario Ministry of Education and Training and is delivered by qualified and dedicated teachers.

### Arts
