Waheed "Ali" Brown began his studies at Albert College in September 1993, and he graduated in June 1998. For Waheed, Albert was his first scholastic experience with true camaraderie and empathy. Both Canada's culture of acceptance and Albert's attitude about service to others deeply shaped Waheed's life choices. Specific events like the annual Terry Fox run, Big Brothers and formal dinners were what exemplified these qualities.

Albert College also prepared Waheed academically, as he graduated as an Ontario Scholar and attended McMaster University's Faculty of Engineering. After graduating from McMaster with a Bachelor of Engineering in Software Engineering, he worked for several big tech companies. Monster.com and Concur (acquired by SAP) were two notable steps in

Waheed's career. While working in Europe, Waheed received a Master of Science in Economics and Finance from Charles University in Prague. Currently, he works as a Cloud Engineer for Google in San Francisco.
